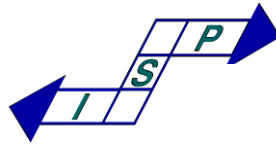

Why Ipswich?

- ✓ **Ipswich** (population 120,000), the county town of Suffolk, is situated 144 km north-east of London, close to the unspoilt Suffolk coast and many picturesque villages. It has an attractive waterfront and some noteworthy historic buildings, including a fine Tudor mansion.
- ✓ Ipswich is not overcrowded with overseas students and offers a typically British environment in which to study.

- ✓ The aim is to improve confidence and language ability, and to give students a better understanding of British life.

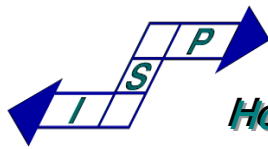
Why stay with a host family?
