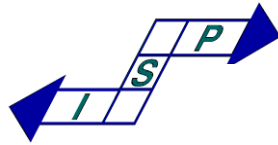

Why Southampton?

- ✓ **Southampton** (population 220,000) is a pleasant university town and an important port situated on the south coast of England, 128 kms south-west of London, close to the New Forest National Park. It has an historic old town, interesting museums, modern waterside areas and many attractive parks.
- ✓ Southampton is not overcrowded with overseas students and offers a typically British environment in which to study.

Why learn with International Study Programmes?

What happens in the English lessons?

- ✓ The aim is to improve confidence and language ability, and to give students a better understanding of British life.

Why stay with a host family?

- ✓ Staying with a British family provides an excellent opportunity to practise English and learn at first hand about the British way of life.

- ✓ Host families give a warm welcome and involve their guests in family life.
- ✓ Each student is guaranteed to be the only person of his/her mother tongue in the family if requested. (*Two friends may ask to stay together if they wish*).
